

## Visibility and weather conditions in Oman (Muscat Area)

This rugged, remote land has nutrient rich waters that support a massive amount of diversity and abundance of marine life. In general the visibility changes from 5 to 30 m.

Month	Visibility in meter	Information
<b>January to February</b>	5 - 15 m	General the visibility is not the best this time (plankton bloom). But low season means less customers and a very relaxed time and a lot of space on the boat. The wind pick up (more waves). <b>Water temperature: 22 – 23 degree</b>
<b>March</b>	5 - 20 m	This month is like April in Europe. The sea condition can be calmed or rough. As well the visibility can be time by time not so well (plankton bloom). <b>Water temperature: 23-24 degree</b>
<b>April to Mai</b>	10 - 30 m	The air and weather temperature becomes warmer and visibility more and more clear. <b>Water temperature: 25 – 29 degree</b>
<b>July to August</b>	05 – 20 m	The visibility changes a lot this time. Sometimes can be good, sometimes the plankton carpets pass by and can change the picture completely. <b>Water temperature: 26 – 30 degree</b>
<b>September to October</b>	10 – 25 m	The visibility change day by day. Less wind makes it possible to go to different dive spots which are more far away. <b>Water temperature: 26 – 30 degree</b>
<b>November to December</b>	10 – 20 m	The visibility change day by day. <b>Water temperature 24 – 27 degree</b>
